## Aurora Medical Center - Grafton

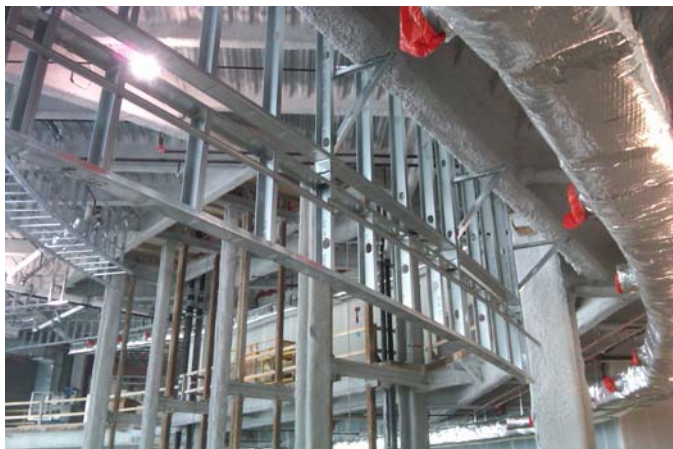
